Marvellous Me

We have had lots of positive feedback from children, teachers and parents about MarvellousMe. We hope we have ironed out the initial teething problems and that you are beginning to receive regular updates about the learning in your child's class. You will have noticed that you cannot message teachers through this new system. This is to protect our teachers' wellbeing, ensuring they are not getting messages from parents in the evenings, at weekends and during holidays. We will have a dedicated mobile number for notifying Mrs Fawcett of any children testing positive for Covid-19 and to enable her to remain on call for track and trace purposes. Each class will also have an email address so that parents can message teachers directly and these will be monitored and responded to during working hours.

Contact Tracing

As from today, we have a dedicated mobile number for anyone needing to contact Mrs Fawcett to inform her of positive cases of Covid-19 in your household. If your child develops symptoms or tests positive for Covid-19, within 48 hours of having been in school, you must inform Mrs Fawcett immediately, so that she can close bubbles and instruct people to isolate as necessary.
