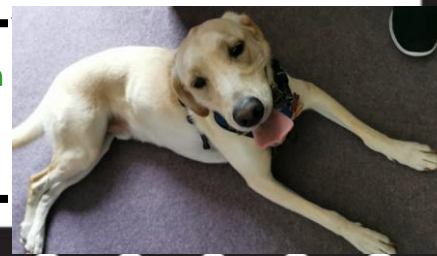
As the weather is turning autumnal, please make sure your child remembers to bring adequate layers with them!
