We are very excited to announce that we have successfully recruited staff to enable us to launch our teatime club provision. We are just awaiting DBS checks and to ensure we have all the equipment we need to get this started. To begin with it will run for 6 months, as a pilot, with places limited to 30. If this is successful and generates a profit for the school, it will be made permanent and more places can then be offered. The club will run until 6pm Monday – Friday, during term time, and places will be booked and paid for using School Money. In a similar way to breakfast club, the prices will vary according to how long your child stays. Healthy snacks and drinks will also be provided. We have a projected launch date of 22nd November - watch this space for confirmation of these arrangements very soon!

Have a lovely half term everyone – see you on Monday 1st November.

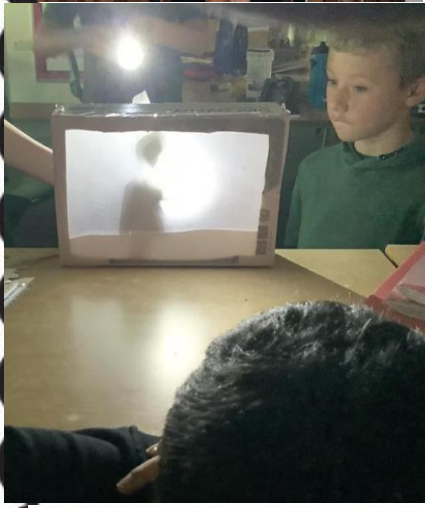
