Catering Manager

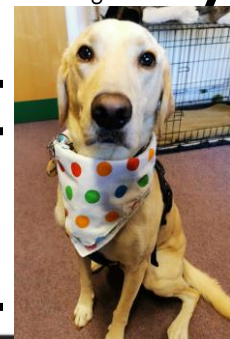

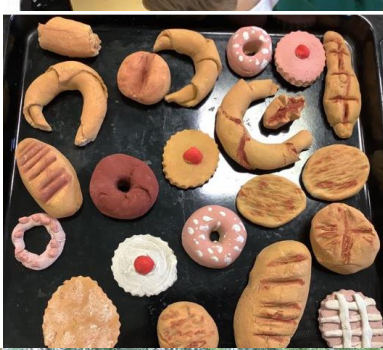
Teatime Club
