### School Improvement Partner Visit

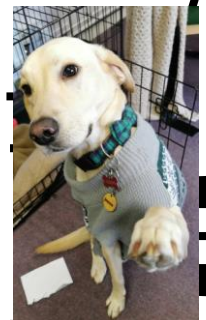
