WHAT MYGROUP DO



MYGroup takes the bottle caps collected by pupils. On-site facilities allow MYGroup to recycle plastics, even the plastics considered 'non-recyclable'.



MYGroup shred the mixed plastics and make them into 100% recycled boards that we then transform into cool products, like chairs, tables, shelters and more, which you can exchange for your Earth Tokens.

We are excited to announce that we have signed up to the Schoolcycle recycling scheme. We need to collect plastic bottle tops and place them in the bins – photos to the left show you where they are! When the bins are full, the bottle tops are weighed and in return the school receives Earth tokens – that can be used in exchange for new items, made from the recycled plastic – such as outdoor furniture, play equipment and so on! Please start saving your bottle tops and bring them in to school!
