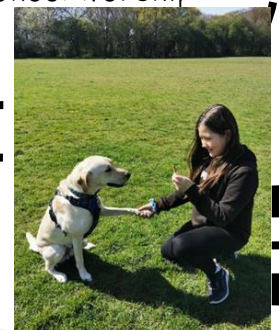
School council cake sale
