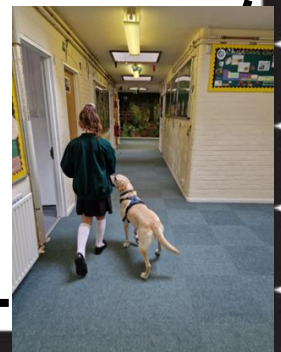

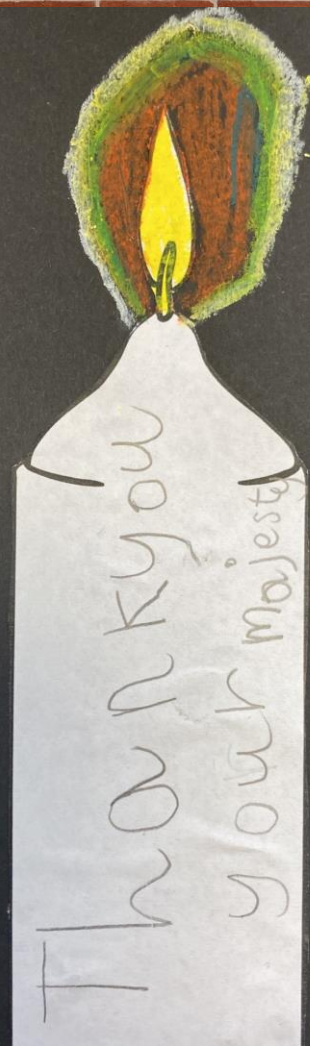
It was lovely to be back in school and sniffing out some good learning!
