Christmas Tree

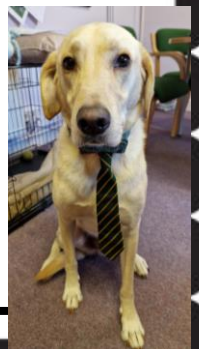
