## Residential

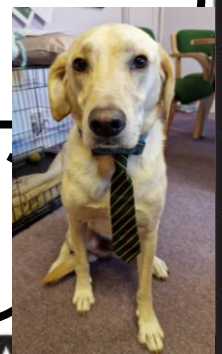

Well done to our amazing key stage one children for their amazing Nativity performances this week and to key stage two for their fantastic carol service – what better ways to start the Christmas celebrations?

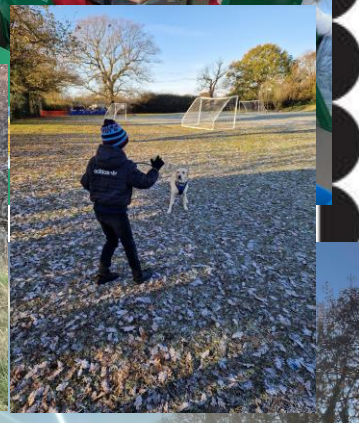
