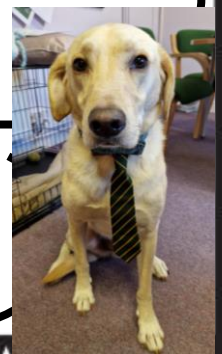
Car park
