Car park

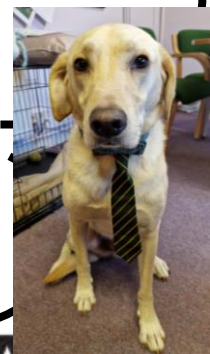
We politely remind parents NOT to park in the staff car park. We have had incidents where staff's cars have been blocked in when they are either leaving for meetings or returning from them.
